HIFDH GRADUATION AND CERTIFICATION CRITERIA

This document lists the Hifdh graduation and certification criteria that all students must meet in order to receive their graduation certificate.



Graduation & Certification Requirements

The <u>minimum</u> requirements for graduation and certification as a Hafidh from An-Noor Qur'an Academy are as follows:

- 1. Student must **uphold lucid**, **respectful**, **and exemplary character and manners throughout his/her time spent in An-Noor Qur'an Academy**, in accordance with the school's Code of Conduct.
- 2. Student must **maintain a C+ or higher testing grade average** throughout time spent in the school.
- 3. Student must always **meet the Minimum Standards in his/her daily assignments (Old, Nearest** and New).
- 4. Student must **recite the entire Qur'an** (via new lessons) **to an official An-Noor school teacher**.
- 5. Student must complete a minimum of 3 cycles (Khatmah) of the entire Qur'an at An-Noor Qur'an Academy. The student must recite with no more than 3 Hifdh mistakes per Juzz in the final cycle of revision (Muraajah). The final cycle can be accomplished in the full-time school or after school revision program.
 - During the 3 revision cycles, the student must maintain a C+ or higher testing grade average (See ANQA Testing and Grading System).
